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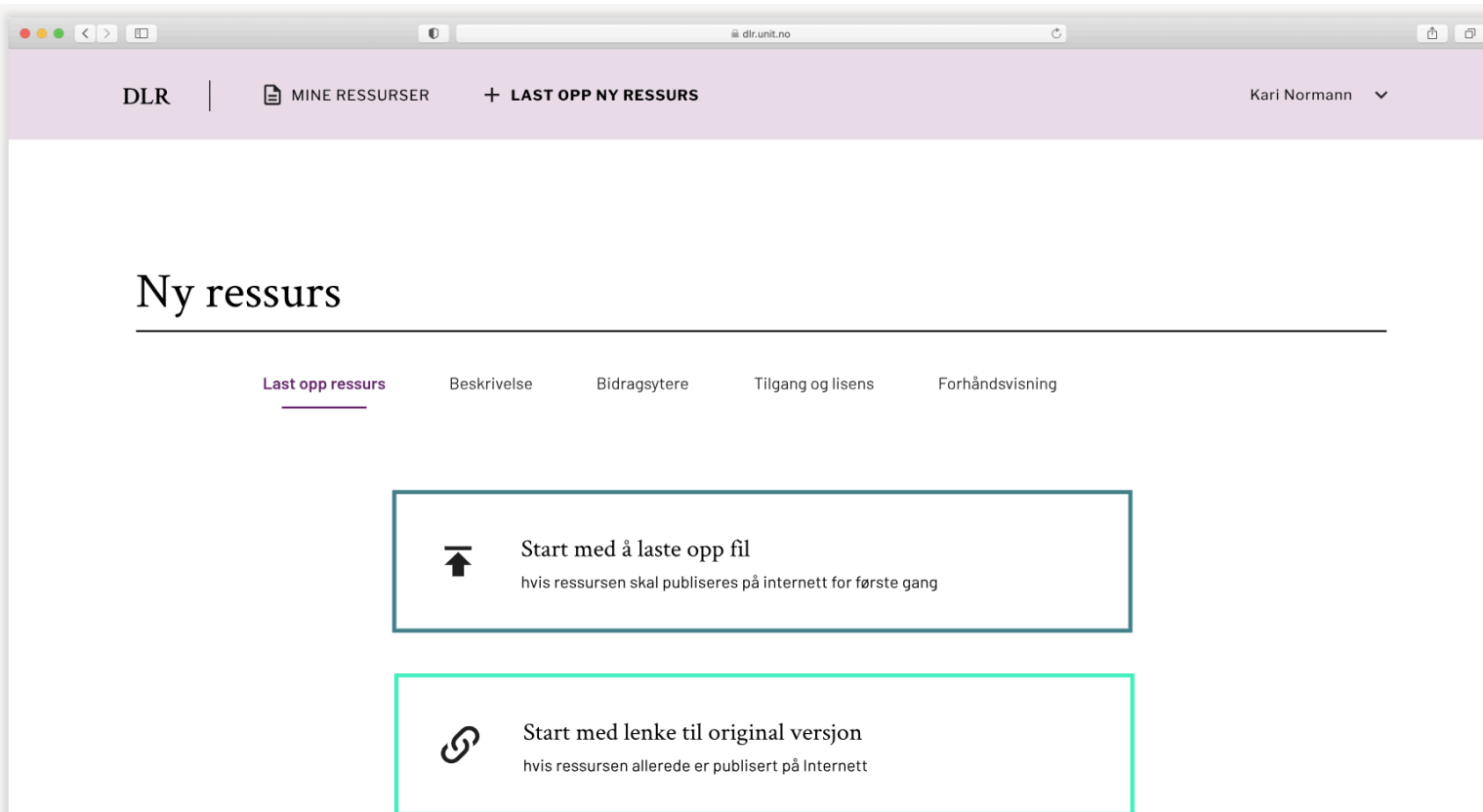

WHAT IS DLR?

(DIGITAL LEARNING RESOURCES)

DLR is a cloud based service for storing and sharing digital learning objectives



*sketch of new user GUI

- Makes it easy to use the learning objectives several places
- VMS, LMS, Institutions, programs, subjects

- Use the learning objective, where it is needed, at any time you want
- There is no need to remember where it is stored, they are easily searchable with help by standardized metadata

- DLR keeps track of all your digital learning objectives and gives them a unique ID

DLR is a Learning Objective Repository (LOR) and is developed by Unit and HE sector in Norway

DLR uses CC-licenses to facilitate the copyright law, and to let other know how they can copy, distribute, and use the learning objective



Why LOR - Learning object repository?

- Many of the systems in the digital learning environment builds in the learning objectives
- Makes it hard to find and share with others
- The LOR stores the learning objectives outside the systems and makes them searchable and shareable

Why share?

- Learning objectives could be shared and rediscovered, without the need of producing the same content several times
- Increase the quality of the teaching
- Become more efficient
- Reduce the risk of «lock-in» the objectives inside a system
- Simplify the process of changing system
- Could possible make content accessible in a lifelong learning perspective
- The advantages of DLR increases in line with increased use and sharing

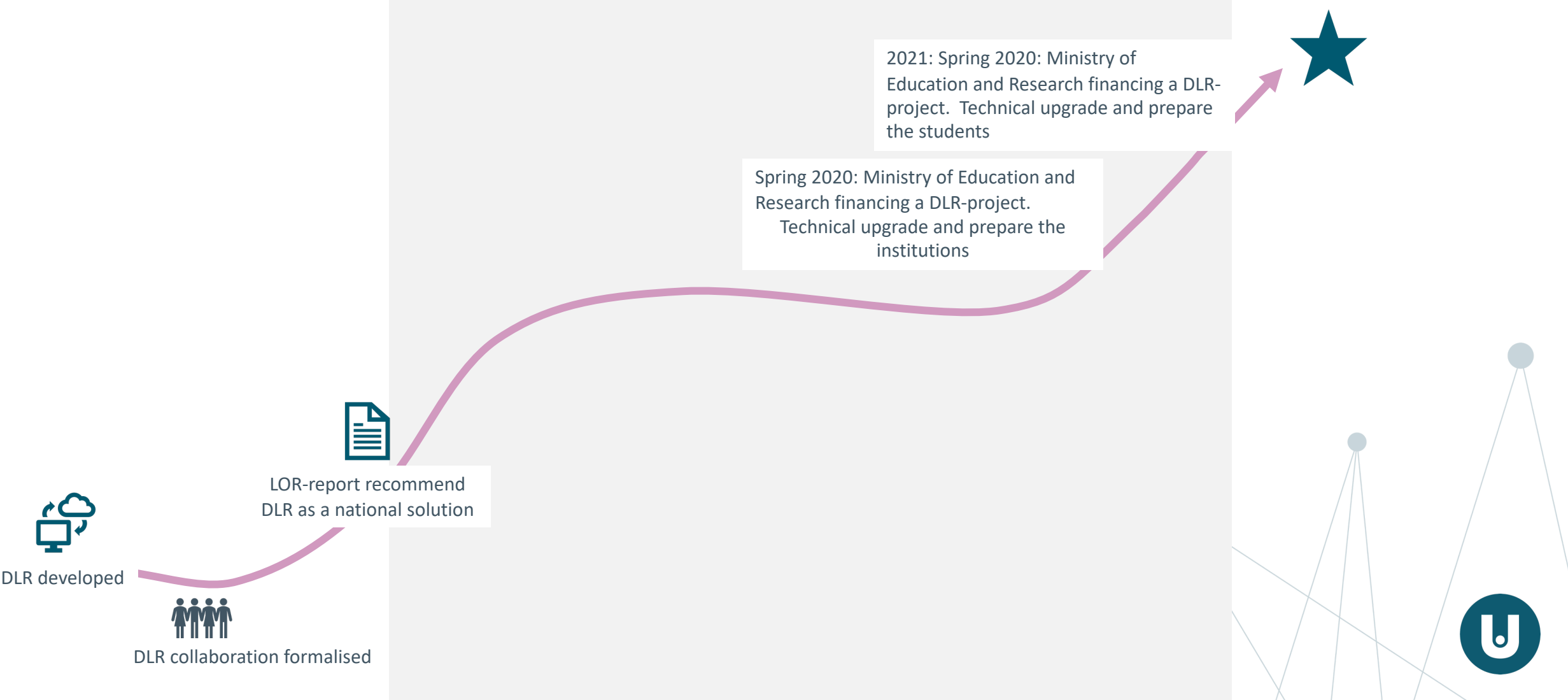


Possible integrations

National investment 2020 og 2021

The Covid 19 pandemic has confirmed the need of a system to share the learning objectives.

- The production of new digitale learning objectives, and especially video has increased
- There is also an increased demand for asynchronous teaching
- Offer a system for sharing

- Financing from Ministry of Education and Research in 2020 and 2021, to support the technical upgrade and prepare the HE sector to receive and use the DLR-service

- Improving the solution and create support material
- Support from the Unit project introducing DLR at the institutions
- Technical upgrade on the system
- The upgrade and the material will be ready in 2021
